C. My Story (Love Changes Everything)

I started my life with so many blessings – loving parents, a peaceful home, good health, a great career, and a beautiful wife and children. Yet I nearly lost everything I valued when a bad storm came because the foundation of my life was built on sand, not on the solid rock of Jesus Christ. I realize that it's only by the grace and mercy of Almighty God that I still have anything and can do anything of lasting value.

As a physician (anesthesiologist), I always had a good income. I had two kids that I was very proud of, but didn't realize what the fruit would be in spoiling them. I was living to retire by the time I was 50 and disciplined myself to save. I was fortunate with my investments. In fact, one year my retirement account grew by \$500,000, earning three times what I did working full-time as a physician. Life looked good before the storm came.

Instead of getting less busy, my days at work became longer and I was being called in for emergency operations much more frequently in the middle of the night. There were several stretches where I didn't see the daylight outside for twelve days in a row.

When I left Culpeper Hospital in July 1999, I felt like I had been let out of jail after twenty years. All of a sudden, my life was my life again. I had been set free from the beeper leash.

I felt secure in myself – with family, money, people skills, and more. I planned to start an Internet company and have a stock offering to make lots of money. However, I didn't realize that a terrible storm was brewing. I was self-centered, not God-centered. I was proud, not humble.

Fortunately, God rescued me by His amazing grace, not because I deserved it, but because He loves me. God gave me a second chance, this time to live for Him. That's why I'm so grateful.

I'm not going to go into detail here with how I met Jesus but let me just say that committing my life to Him on January 6, 2001 (Epiphany Sunday) was by far the most important decision I have ever made in my entire life. He revolutionized my life and impact, both at work and at home.

D. Lessons I Have Learned Along The Way

- Lesson #1: LOVE God and Love People
 - o "I will greet this day with love in my heart!" The Greatest Salesman in the World
 - My theme verse for life is the Greatest Commandment to love God with all my being and to love my neighbor as myself.
 - Jesus said the entire Bible can be summarized in that. So LIFE is about RELATIONSHIPS. We are instructed to love God first and foremost and then to manifest God's love in our relationships with people.
 - To love people fully, you must love yourself fully. Whatever you are willing to do for others, be willing to do for yourself.
 - Loving yourself is manifested in how you renew your mind, feed your spirit, and take care of the only body you will ever have. Eating well, exercising regularly, and getting plenty of rest are very important.
- Lesson #2: TIME is your LIFE!!!
 - When you waste your time, you waste your life!
 - Time is your most valuable resource, so steward it well.

- If you want better relationships and more wisdom, learn to "number your days."

 - To be spiritually healthy, you must ruthlessly eliminate hurry from your life!
 - Journaling is a healthy habit that helps you SLOW DOWN. This leads to REST,

 - Journaling helps ELIMINATE HURRY from your life! Love and hurry are incompatible. Jesus was never in a hurry, not even one time.
 - We live in a hurry-sick culture! If you're not in a hurry right now, there is someone in your life who wants to make you be.
 - Good habits are the key to all success! If done properly, Spiritual Journaling will transform your life! Learn to work harder on yourself than on your job!!!
- Lesson #4 The 60-60 Experiment will revolutionize your life
 - When you stay connected with God, fruit happens!
 - The 60-60 Experiment is a simple habit to receive DIVINE GUIDANCE moment by moment. It's about letting the Holy Spirit be the navigator for your life!

E. Five Things Holding You Back

Just as every great athlete has a coach, so does every great life!

There's a BIG DIFFERENCE between those who SOAR and those who STRUGGLE. After years of experience, journaling, and reflection, I've discovered five things keeping you from having what you desire:

1) Your MINDSET

Not believing who God says you are.

Not believing you are an EXPERT at something (e.g. your niche) and that you should be paid well for your advice. Until you get over this hurdle, you will be limited with how far and how fast you can go.

Everyone is unique and has the potential to be a master at something. But even when you know you are an expert, you must follow a simple step-by-step plan for making an impact and an income with what you know.

2) CLEAR VISION — Clarity & Focus

Definition: Knowing exactly what you want, in measurable and reachable ways that are INTENSELY CLEAR, ultra specific, and totally inspiring to you.

Vision is crucial to get to where you desire. Without knowing your destination, you will

end up somewhere, but it's unlikely it is where you long to be.

3) SMARTT GOALS

Understanding how to set goals and act on them in ways that work for you and produce results at an exceptional level.

4) COACHING

Having a powerful partner (coach) committed to your success — challenging, cherishing, and cheering you along the way to victory.

5) TEAM

Teamwork makes the dream work.

Every highly successful leader has a TEAM and almost every highly successful leader has a mastermind team.

[Overcoming a poverty mindset]

There are many political theories about eradicating poverty, but my concern is not with that. My concern is with eradicating poverty from our thinking.

Most of us spend time looking at our bank accounts to see if we can pay the rent or mortgage, pay some debt off, and make it to another month. We are trained in poverty thinking.

A poverty mindset, often characterized by a deep-seated belief that scarcity and lack are the default states of life, can significantly hinder you from investing in yourself and your ministry. This mindset manifests in various ways, impacting decision-making, risk-taking, and overall growth. Here's how a poverty mindset can be a major roadblock:

- **Fear of Spending**: Individuals with a poverty mindset often fear spending money, even on worthwhile investments. They might view spending on personal development, coaching, or business growth as unnecessary expenses rather than valuable investments. This fear can prevent them from accessing resources that could enhance their skills, expand their ministries, or grow their businesses.
- **Limited Vision**: A poverty mindset can limit one's vision and aspirations. It often leads to thinking small and avoiding setting ambitious goals. Without the belief in abundance and growth, individuals may not see the potential in expanding their ministries or businesses, thus missing out on opportunities for advancement.
