- Creating Financial Freedom
 - Imagine being able to turn on a water faucet at will any time you are thirsty. That is what the LORD has taught me regarding wealth.
 - My goal is to help create 2,000 enlightened millionaires by 2030. Why? The cascade effect of these millionaires sharing their wealth (both in knowledge and cash) will positively change the economic future of many people and transform culture.

 - Definition of Prosperity: You have no financial debt and you have more than enough resources to fulfill every divine assignment God has for you and enough left to help others fulfill theirs.
 - If God can get money through you, He'll get money to you ... And there will be plenty left over for you.
 - As a Kingdom Wealth Builder, you turn dollars into soldiers to accomplish Kingdom purposes.
 - Prosperity starts with WHO you have, not WHAT you have.
 - Question: How much money is too much money? Answer: Whatever amount replaces trust in God.
 - Money is to the natural realm what the anointing is to the spiritual realm: It is a way to make things happen.
 - One of the biggest problems that people immediately have with teaching on prosperity comes from the belief that prosperity is selfish.
 - Why Christians struggle with money
 - The #1 reason Christians struggle with money: "My people perish for a lack of knowledge." (Hosea 4:6)
 - When it comes to money, there are two paths: The path of earned income, or the path of passive income.
 - You can work for money, or money can work for you.
 - A good goal: Income from investments > living expenses.
 - The #2 reason Christians struggle with money: Answer: Lack of a personalized WEALTH MAP.

The Eradication of Poverty

[Overcoming a poverty mindset]

There are many political theories about eradicating poverty, but my concern is not with that. My concern is with eradicating poverty from our thinking.

Most of us spend time looking at our bank accounts to see if we can pay the rent or mortgage, pay some debt off, and make it to another month. We are trained in poverty thinking.

A poverty mindset, often characterized by a deep-seated belief that scarcity and lack are the default states of life, can significantly hinder you from investing in yourself and your ministry. This mindset manifests in various ways, impacting decision-making, risk-taking, and overall growth. Here's how a poverty mindset can be a major roadblock:

- **Fear of Spending:** Individuals with a poverty mindset often fear spending money, even on worthwhile investments. They might view spending on personal development, coaching, or business growth as unnecessary expenses rather than valuable investments. This fear can prevent them from accessing resources that could enhance their skills, expand their ministries, or grow their businesses.
- **Limited Vision:** A poverty mindset can limit one's vision and aspirations. It often leads to thinking small and avoiding setting ambitious goals. Without the belief in abundance and growth, individuals may not see the potential in expanding their ministries or businesses, thus missing out on opportunities for advancement.
- **Resistance to Risk:** Investing in oneself or one's business often involves some level of risk. A poverty mindset breeds a heightened fear of failure, leading to risk aversion. This can result in missed opportunities, as the individual may avoid taking calculated risks that could lead to significant growth and success.
- **Undervaluing Oneself:** People with a poverty mindset may struggle to recognize their own worth and the value of their services. This can lead to undercharging for their work or not investing in their personal and professional development. As a result, they might not attract the clientele that sees the value in higher-priced, quality services.
- **Short-term Focus:** A poverty mindset often leads to a focus on immediate needs rather than long-term planning and investment. This short-term thinking can hinder the development of strategies that require upfront investment but offer long-term benefits, such as building an online presence or investing in marketing and lead generation.
- **Neglecting Networking and Collaboration:** Investing in relationships and networks is crucial for personal and business growth. A poverty mindset can cause individuals to

overlook the importance of networking, mentorship, and collaboration, limiting their exposure to new ideas, opportunities, and partnerships.

- **Lack of Resilience:** The fear and scarcity mentality associated with a poverty mindset can lead to a lack of resilience in the face of challenges. Individuals may give up easily when faced with obstacles, rather than viewing them as opportunities for growth and learning.
